[ 1 ] [ ] 内の動詞を使って、与えられた日本語の意味に合うように空所を埋めなさい。

1. The officer demanded that I (should) show my ID card to him. [私が ID を見せることを求めた]
2. The doctor recommended that my father (should) have surgery. [父に手術を受けることを勧めた]
3. He suggested that I (should) study pharmacy at the university. [私が薬学の勉強をする提案をした]  
[ suggest / demand / recommend ]

[ 2 ] 日本語の意味に合うように、( ) に適語を入れなさい。

1. 彼がその計画に反対しているとは驚きだった。  
It was ( **surprising** ) that he ( **should** ) ( **be** ) opposed to the plan.
2. スティーブは自分の事業を始めると私に話した。  
Steve ( **told** ) ( **me** ) that ( **he** ) ( **would** ) start his own business.
3. 彼女が教育の価値に気づいたのは最近のことだった。  
It was ( **not** ) ( **until** ) ( **recently** ) that she realized the value of education.
4. お昼を食べ終わるとすぐに、ベルが鳴り響いた。  
We ( **had** ) ( **hardly** ) ( **finished** ) our lunch ( **when** ) the bell rang.
5. この大学が創設されてから 100 年たちます。  
It ( **has** ) ( **been** ) a hundred years since this university ( **was** ) ( **founded** ).

[ 3 ] 空所を埋めて、間接話法の文を完成させなさい。

1. My father said, "You have to wait here until I'm back."  
My father told me to wait there until he was back.
2. The salesclerk said to me, "I'll call you tomorrow."  
The salesclerk told me that he / she would call me the next day.
3. My great-grandmother said to me, "Do you remember me?"  
My great-grandmother asked me if I remembered her.
4. I said to him, "What are you going to buy for her birthday?"  
I asked him what he was going to buy for her birthday.

[ 4 ] [ ] 内の語句を使って、日本語の意味に合う英文をつくりなさい。

1. 自分のことをきちんと表現できることは、きわめて重要です。[ you / able / properly ]  
It is essential that you (should) be able to express yourself properly.
2. ほかの文化を理解しようとすることは、とても大切です。[ quite / try ]  
It is quite important that you (should) try to understand other cultures.
3. 彼女は自分の娘があつて若者とつきあっていることを知らなかった。[ go out with ]  
She didn't know that her daughter was going out with that young man.
4. 私はそのとき、その問題はすでに解決されたと思っていた。[ that time / problem ]  
I thought at that time that the problem had already been solved.
5. 彼はすぐに、そこで新しい友だちをつくることでしょう。[ long / make ]  
It won't be long before he makes new friends there.
